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TOWN OF NAPLES BOARD MEETING

October 11, 2021

CALL TO ORDER:

The Town of Naples Board Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Town Chairman Dennis Olson presiding over the meeting at Naples Town Hall, S283 County Road BB, Mondovi, WI 54755.

ROLL CALL:

Board members present: Town Chairman, Dennis Olson, First Supervisor, Paul Accola, Second Supervisor, Brett Cole, Town Treasurer, Andy Goss, and Town Clerk, Jackie Dregney. Also present were Sue Iverson, Bryan Wulff, Barb Allemann, Llyod McQuiston, and Cathy Cole.

APPROVE MINUTES:

Motion by Accola and seconded by Cole to approve the minutes from September 13, 2021. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

No comments.

REDISTRICTING OF VOTING DISTRICT:

Discussion regarding redistricting to voting districts. The Town of Naples will have no change.

RECYCLING AGREEMENT WITH BUFFALO COUNTY:

Motion by Accola, seconded by Cole to approve using Buffalo County for recycling purposes and approve updated contract as proposed. Motion carried.

PRELIMINARY BUDGET REVIEW:

The budget was not complete for review. No action.

FRONT DOOR AT TOWN HALL:

Front door is aging and in need of replacement. Olson will contact Gonstead Construction for a quote; will forward to board members when received. No action.

ALLEMAN ROAD BRIDGE UPDATE:

Olson shared tentative completion will be first week in November; rails are complete; the state will have their walk through for approval on October 26, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. No action.

DNR WATER REPORT CONTACTS UPDATE:

Letter received regarding contact updates for the water testing compliance with the DNR. Todd Hanson has completed and sent in to state. No action.

T.R.I.P FUNDS ROAD ALLOCATION:

Meeting for Town Roads Improvement Plan (T.R.I.P) will be held at the Buffalo Co. Highway Department on Thursday, October 14, 2021 at 9:30 a.m. Three towns will share funding on an allocated road. It is required that an allocated road must be double-chip sealed or paved. Funding amounts are not available until the meeting and a road must be named for the project at the meeting. The town will have six years to complete the project. Funding is on a rotational basis with townships. Cole and Segerstrom Road both qualify for the project. Motion by Cole to propose Cole Road on the County BB end for the funds. Accola commented there is more through traffic on Segerstrom Road vs. Cole Road. After further discussion there was no second and the motion died.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION/MAINTENANCE:

Town will get 150 ton of sand from Buffalo County. Olson advised patching in the coming weeks, including the approaches on Ward Road bridge; mowing on Nichols Road; grading of gravel roads. No action.

2-YEAR ROAD PLAN:

Road plans submitted by supervisors will be looked at by Olson and updated at November meeting. No action.

5-YEAR HISTORY ON STATE REIMBURSEMENT:

General Transportation Aid was discussed on how the amount is dispersed. Total of revenues were given for discussion on further road improvements. Broadband expenses will be the forefront of priorities for the upcoming year. No action.

UPDATE ON TCC BROADBAND PROJECT:

Olson talked to Buck Webb regarding broadband grant applied for. Over 240 townships applied for the Public Service Commission (PSC) Grant for broadband. There may be a possible deduction in monetary awards; they are waiting on the PSC award announcement at the end of October. No action.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS:

Olson stated road ratings will be conducted by the County as it has been in past years.

PAYMENT OF BILLS:

All bills were presented and paid.

SET NEXT MEETING DATE:

The next meeting for the Town of Naples Board will be held November 8, 2021 following the Budget Hearing and Special Meeting of Electors at 6:00 p.m.

ADJOURNMENT: At 7:15 p.m. meeting was adjourned.
