BROADBAND UPDATE

Due to weather, TCC is running a couple weeks behind with connecting fiber to homes. They were planning to start mid-January, but will be toward the end of the month.

ROAD GRANT

Olson shared grant information and the importance of continuing to apply to show interest. Motion by Cole and seconded by Accola to reapply for the road grants with Oakridge Engineering. Motion carried.

Deadlines to have a possible road referendum on the ballot could not be met, and will need to be looked at in the future. Motion by Cole and seconded by Accola to rescind all referendum items regarding roads. Motion carried.
