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TOWN OF NAPLES BOARD MEETING

May 18, 2026

CALL TO ORDER:

The Town of Naples Monthly Board Meeting was called to order at 6:04 p.m. by Town Chairman, Ross Kruger presiding over the meeting at Naples Town Hall, S283 County Road BB, Mondovi, WI 54755

ROLL CALL

Board members present: Town Chairman, Ross Kruger, First Supervisor, Neil Segerstrom, Second Supervisor, Scott Smith, Town Treasurer, Pamela Hansen, and Town Clerk, Jackie Dregney.

CITIZEN'S COMMENTS

Bonnie Mercer, Tanner Road was present to discuss the condition of Tanner Road. Her garbage company stated they will not service her trash containers with the road being washed out in front of her driveway. She has used rock of her own to fill in the ruts, but they continue to get washed out. She is looking for a timeframe and plan to repair the road. She believes the washouts have gotten worse after the vegetation was removed on the south side of the road. She submitted a video to Kruger showing the path of the running water off a field causing the damage. Kruger is currently working on a plan for Tanner Road as another resident has brought about a complaint. Tollefson will fill in the ditches by the driveway until the ditching and culvert placement can occur. The culvert cost will be the responsibility of the homeowner as acknowledged by Mercer.

APPROVE MINUTES FROM APRIL MEETING

Motion by Segerstrom and seconded by Smith to approve the April 21 minutes. Motion carried.

COMPUTER PURCHASE FOR TREASURER

Hansen brought computer quotes to the April meeting for the replacement of her town computer. It was discussed at that time to look at contracting with GoMonthly IT to consider a monthly payment of \$14.95 for an updated computer. The plan will be for a never out-dated computer. When the current computer is outdated, it will simply be replaced with an updated one for as long as we have the service. After discussion on the more cost-effective plan, motion by Smith and seconded by Segerstrom to move forward with the contract with GoMonthly It. Motion carried.

CHAIR REPORT

Kruger updated on Pace Road repairs. The county will finish the work by the end of July 2026. Tollefson will start removing stumps this week. Kruger has not received a quote on the chip sealing. Funds from the Town Road Improvement Program (TRIP) will be used on this project. Ditch brushing should be finishing up soon. Kruger spoke with Bruce Schmidtknecht regarding sandblasting of the dump truck and he will bring that to next month's meeting.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Hansen asked about the state reimbursement for Segerstrom Road status. It was submitted on April 7 with no word on when we will receive our funds. Budget sheets were reviewed.
