TOWN OF NAPLES BOARD MEETING April 10, 2024

CALL TO ORDER:

The Town of Naples Monthly Board Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Town Chairman, Ross Kruger presiding over the meeting at Naples Town Hall, S283 County Road BB, Mondovi, WI 54755

ROLL CALL

Board members present: Town Chairman, Ross Kruger, and First Supervisor, Neil Segerstrom, Second Supervisor, Scott Smith, Town Treasurer, Pamela Hansen, and Town Clerk, Jackie Dregney.

CITIZEN'S COMMENTS

APPROVE MINUTES FROM MARCH 11 MEETING

Motion by Segerstrom and seconded by Smith to approve the March 11 minutes. Motion carried.

IVERSON FAMILY PROPERTY ON YOUTH ROAD

Mark, Scot, and Eric Iverson were present to propose the township taking over their quarter-mile driveway as a road. There is currently not enough frontage for them to parcel the land from the buildings if desired. Kruger would like to pursue other options. Discussion on using the neighboring driveway for access to the land. More information on unmaintained roads and possible other options will be researched and brought back to a future meeting. No action.

LRIP/ARIP UPDATE

The Local Roads Improvement Program (LRIP) information has not crossed the Governor's desk. Will keep on agenda for action/discussion. July 1, 2024 is the deadline for the Agriculture Road Improvement Program (ARIP) applications. Possibly could shorten the Segerstrom Road project. If awarded this 90/10 cost-share grant, the TRIP dollars received would be allocated to another road.

BRUSH TRIMMING

Tollefson has completed much of the neglected brush trimming and will continue to work on the remaining roads.

2024 ROAD MAINTENANCE PLAN

The Segerstrom Road project will remain on hold until information is received on the status of the LRIP funding. Cathy Cole was present to discuss the deterioration of Cole Road particularly the backside of the road. Kruger met with Buffalo County and will get a price on double chip sealing Cole Road. Possibly transferring TRIP dollars to Cole Road if funding is awarded for Segerstrom Road. Will be brought back to future meeting. Hovey Valley Road needs chip sealing and patches. Wulff Road south end is deteriorating. It was recommended to blade patch and replace Wulff Road in the future.

BRIDGE INSPECTIONS UPDATE

No major bridge issues were found. Kruger reviewed the recommendations by Delmar and Tollefson will complete the repairs that are needed. Tollefson was supplied with the documentations from Delmar for bridge repairs.

NEW SHOP DISCUSSION

Oakridge Engineering has not completed plans for a possible new shop. Will bring to a future meeting.

RECORDS RETENTION

Smith shared his desire to go through records retention. He would like to meet in the summer to sift through what is permanent records and what can be destroyed. Discussion of adopting the General Records Schedule for retention. Smith will schedule a date in the summer once school is out to sort through the file cabinets and start organizing the records stored at the Town Hall.

CHAIR REPORT

Kruger touched on all points in previous discussion.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Hansen reported that all personal property taxes have been collected.

PAYMENT OF BILLS PRESENTED

Bills were paid as presented.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION

Possibly adopting the county ordinance of times and rules for ATV/UTV traffic.
