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TOWN OF NAPLES BOARD MEETING

March 23, 2026

CALL TO ORDER:

The Town of Naples Monthly Board Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Town Chairman, Ross Kruger presiding over the meeting at Naples Town Hall, S283 County Road BB, Mondovi, WI 54755

ROLL CALL

Board members present: Town Chairman, Ross Kruger, First Supervisor, Neil Segerstrom, Second Supervisor, Scott Smith, Town Treasurer, Pamela Hansen (arrived at 6:07), and Town Clerk, Jackie Dregney.

CITIZEN'S COMMENTS

Craig Brenner, W371 Sand Road was present to talk about Sand Road and what the plan was if any to help alleviate the low spots and the ditching. He stated it is getting hard to travel on the road. Kruger and Tollefson discussed ditch work and trying to get the grade up near the house. A culvert may be needed in the area as well. They agreed to concentrate on the west-end of Sand Road and to work on getting that portion graded to make it better passable. Kruger and Tollefson will look at the road and will compile a plan once the site visit is complete.

Andy Schneider with Farmstead Woodworking was also present to update on the town hall siding construction. He shared that five more sections of siding were ordered and that it should be completed by the end of next week.

APPROVE MINUTES FROM FEBRUARY MEETING

Motion by Smith and seconded by Segerstrom to approve February 16 minutes with the addition of adding the names of the roads the culverts are located for the LLSIP funding. Motion carried.

YULE LANE CSM RESOLUTION R-26-03-01

Motion by Segerstrom and seconded by Smith to approve Resolution R-26-03-01 approving the acceptance of adding Yule Lane to become a town road and to be maintained by the town. Motion carried.

YULE LANE SIGN

A road sign will be purchased for Yule Lane.

LRIP FUNDS ROAD TRANSFER

Notice was received from the Local Road Improvement Program that funds must be reimbursed or transferred to another road as the original designated Cole Road was paved. These funds must be used on a gravel road for double chip sealing. Discussion on possible roads to transfer to were Pace, Moe, or Doc Road. Motion by Segerstrom and seconded by Smith to transfer the LRIP funds for double chip sealing to Pace Road with completion by June 30, 2027. Motion carried.

CHAIR REPORT

Kruger commended Tollefson on the great work clearing the roads during the historic snowstorm that fell on March 15. A quote was received for town hall signs to place on the building from Edge Graphics for \$611.38. Motion by Segerstrom and seconded by Smith to approve the purchase of the signs. Motion carried.

The outdoor light was discussed and will be replaced with an LED light.

After the February meeting it was realized that Oakridge Engineering had already completed work on the Local Small Structure Improvement Program (LSSIP) that was originally approved to have Jewell Engineering complete. A Motion to amend by Smith and seconded by Segerstrom the previously adopted motion and to approve switching the LSSIP work to Oakridge from Jewell due to time and dollars already incurred to Oakridge engineering. Motion carried.
