TOWN OF NAPLES BOARD MEETING

April 21, 2026

CALL TO ORDER:

The Town of Naples Monthly Board Meeting was called to order at 6:14 p.m. by Town Chairman, Ross Kruger presiding over the meeting at Naples Town Hall, S283 County Road BB, Mondovi, WI 54755

ROLL CALL

Board members present: Town Chairman, Ross Kruger, First Supervisor, Neil Segerstrom, Second Supervisor, Scott Smith, Town Treasurer, Pamela Hansen, and Town Clerk, Jackie Dregney.

CITIZEN'S COMMENTS

Ed Miller was present to discuss the condition of Knapp Road. Road is washed out and in need of repair. Mr. Miller noted that Tollefson has done a good job of keeping it crowned and filling the ditches, but the condition has worsened. Kruger acknowledged grants that he continues to work on for town roads. Tollefson will look at the condition and noted the latest snowfall was very hard on the roads, especially the gravel ones.

David Saxe was present to notify the board he will be working on removing the fence along Nelson Road by July. He would like to replace the fence at some point to pasture cattle.

RESOLUTION 26-04-01 SUPPORTING COMPREHENSIVE AND SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION FUNDING SOLUTION

Motion by Smith and seconded by Segerstrom to approve Resolution R-26-04-01 approving supporting continued funding for comprehensive and sustainable transportation funding solution. This resolution asks representatives to keep pushing for continued funding for town roads. Motion carried. The Resolution will be submitted to local representatives via email by Dregney.

CHAIR REPORT

Kruger noted Oakridge Engineering submitted the Small Structures Improvement Program (LSSIP). He spoke with the county regarding the TRIP cost-share for Pace Road and they would like that completed by the end of July of 2026. Discussed removing stumps on Pace Road and Kruger will reach out to Dave Pace. Biddings will be advertised for future Gonty Road construction.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Hansen shared the Budget for 2025 and current for 2026. She presented costs for a new computer to replace an aged computer that is outdated. This item will be brought to next month's meeting for approval.
