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TOWN OF NAPLES BOARD MEETING

June 15, 2026

CALL TO ORDER:

The Town of Naples Monthly Board Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Town Chairman, Ross Kruger presiding over the meeting at Naples Town Hall, S283 County Road BB, Mondovi, WI 54755

ROLL CALL

Board members present: Town Chairman, Ross Kruger, First Supervisor, Neil Segerstrom, Second Supervisor, Scott Smith, Town Clerk, Jackie Dregney. Absent was Town Treasurer, Pamela Hansen.

CITIZEN'S COMMENTS

Bruce Wulff was present to discuss the condition of Wulff Road and inquired about planned maintenance. Tollefson and Kruger answered his questions and Tollefson will drive the road and fill in potholes as needed. Kruger explained the cost of road construction and adding Wulff Road to possible grant funding in the future.

APPROVE MINUTES FROM MAY MEETING

Motion by Smith and seconded by Segerstrom to approve the May 18 minutes. Motion carried.

SANDBLASTING DUMP TRUCK

Kruger discussed the dump truck and the rust condition it is in. He spoke with Bruce Schmidtknecht to have it sand blasted. Cost would be \$8k-\$10k. Tollefson suggested replacing the cable box that holds the controls. Kruger would like to work with Buffalo County on using their shop to spray the truck off a couple times a year during winter months to help with rusting. Motion by Smith and seconded by Segerstrom to have the dump truck sandblasted by Schmidtknecht. Motion carried.

BUFFALO COUNTY CHIP SEALING

Oakridge Engineering submitted costs associated with the completion of Pace Road that was awarded the Town Road Improvement Program (TRIP) grant. Not including the ditching and tree removal the cost exceeded \$83,000. Discussion of not doing the double chip seal and proceed with building the road up, ditching, and removing stumps. The Board felt spending that amount of money to save the grant amount of \$20,000 was not visible. Motion by Segerstrom and seconded by Smith to continue with the reshaping only and not chip sealing due to the cost. Motion carried. The TRIP grant will become available for use on another road in the future.

Three quotes were submitted by the county for Nelson Road. Motion by Segerstrom and seconded by Smith to accept the single chip sealing of Nelson Road by Buffalo County for an approximate total of \$37,000. Motion carried. Work will begin in July.

TOWN HALL SIDING DAMAGE UPDATE

Dregney was notified by the insurance company of Waste Management that there was no proof that their truck hit and damaged the siding at the town hall, therefore, the claim was denied. Discussion of replacing the full panel siding or patching to fix the damage. Motion by Kruger and seconded by Segerstrom to repair the full panel sheet of siding for a cost of \$1,400. Motion carried. The dumpsters have now been relocated away from the building to prevent them from hitting the building.

APPROVE BEER AND LIQUOR RETAIL LICENSES

Motion by Kruger and seconded by Segerstrom to approve the retail licenses for "Class B" Liquor and Beer to Dancing Yarrow, LLC; Class "B" beer and "Class C" Wine to M.A.'s Food and Events, LLC; Class "A" Beer to Together Farms, LLC, and Class "B" Beer to Lazy L Tack and Trailers, LLC. Motion carried.

APPROVE OPERATOR LICENSES

Motion by Smith and seconded by Kruger to approve operator licenses for: Rebecca Loomis, Susan Loomis, Kristen Loomis, Stephanie Schneider, Whitney Krebich, and Maria Bamonti. Motion carried.

CHAIR REPORT

Stump removal will continue on Pace Road. Cole Road washouts have improved immensely. Tollefson is pleased with how it has held up.
