All polling places are accessible to elderly and disabled voters.

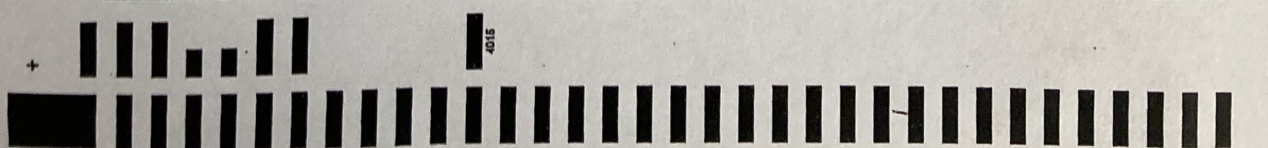
Notice of Meeting of the Local Board of Canvassers
