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TOWN OF NAPLES BOARD MEETING June 10, 2024

CALL TO ORDER:

The Town of Naples Monthly Board Meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. by Town Chairman, Ross Kruger presiding over the meeting at Naples Town Hall, S283 County Road BB, Mondovi, WI 54755

ROLL CALL

APPROVE MINUTES FROM MAY MEETING

Motion by Smith and seconded by Segerstrom to approve the May 13 minutes. Motion carried.

IVERSON FAMILY PROPERTY ON YOUTH ROAD

Kruger explained the town can not have an unmaintained road as a resident suggested. The road would need to meet certain standards and are not feasible to the township. Kruger proposed Iversons build the road and it could possibly be adopted by the township. The board agreed it would not be a benefit to the majority of the general public. The landowner could create the road allowing the township to take it over at no expense to the town. No action.

SHERIFF OSMOND – FLOCK CAMERAS

Sheriff Osmond was present to give an overview of a license plate reading camera the county is asking townships to support and install. The camera is solar-powered and would be installed at the county entrance on Highway 10 east near the Trempealeau County line. The cameras would only be used in cases where a vehicle was involved in a crime or accident. The cameras cost \$3,000 per year plus installation. The board will bring back to the next meeting for action.

APPROVE BEER AND LIQUOR RETAIL LICENSES

Motion by Smith and seconded by Segerstrom to approve the retail licenses for "Class B" Liquor and Beer to Dancing Yarrow, LLC; Class "B" beer and "Class C" Wine to M.A.'s Food and Events, LLC; Class "A" Beer to Together Farms, LLC, and Class "B" Beer to Lazy L Tack and Trailers, LLC. Motion carried.

APPROVE OPERATOR LICENSES

Motion by Smith and seconded by Segerstrom to approve operator licenses for: Rebecca Loomis, Susan Loomis, Kristen Loomis, Stephanie Schneider, Jody Holden, Amanda Talford, and Maria Bamonti. Motion carried.

ATV/UTV ADOPTION OF COUNTY ORDINANCE 24-03-01

Motion by Smith and seconded by Segerstrom to adopt the county's ordinance regarding rules of operating all-terrain vehicles and utility-terrain vehicles on township roads. Motion carried.

LRIP/ARIP UPDATE

Kruger stated he is leaning on Oakridge Engineering to get the application done. The town proposes to shorten the scope and transferring previous awarded TRIP Program dollars of \$19,876.90 to Cole Road.

COLE ROAD TRIP

The dollars awarded to the town for Segerstrom Road will be transferred to Cole Road if allowed. No action.

CHAIR REPORT

Kruger touched on all points in previous discussions.

TREASURER'S REPORT
