TOWN OF NAPLES BOARD MEETING August 18, 2025

CALL TO ORDER:

The Town of Naples Monthly Board Meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m. by Town Chairman, Ross Kruger presiding over the meeting at Naples Town Hall, S283 County Road BB, Mondovi, WI 54755

ROLL CALL

Board members present: Town Chairman, Ross Kruger, First Supervisor, Neil Segerstrom, Second Supervisor, Scott Smith, Town Treasurer, Pamela Hansen, and Town Clerk, Jackie Dregney.

APPROVE MINUTES FROM JULY MEETING

Motion by Segerstrom and seconded by Smith to approve July 21 minutes. Motion carried.

SEGERSTROM ROAD CONSTRUCTION FINAL PAY REQUEST AND PROJECT CLOSEOUT

Lepke Construction submitted the final payment for Segerstrom Road. Due to heavy rainfall parts of the road were washed and in need of repair. After discussion there was a motion by Smith to make payment number four to Lepke less the 5% retainer pending completion of the punch list of areas that need repair submitted to Lepke by Oakridge Engineering. Seconded by Segerstrom. Motion carried.

TOWN HALL SIDING UPDATE

After review of options, Kruger recommends applying steel siding to the town hall. Installation will be completed by Andy Schneider for a total of \$24,447. Work will be completed by fall. Motion by Kruger and seconded by Segerstrom to move forward with Andy Schneider applying steel to the town hall. Motion carried.

ROAD CULVERT DISCUSSION

Petition bills were received from Buffalo County for work that was done in 2023 and not billed in 2024. Alleman Bridge amount owed is still not completed by the state. Kruger will inquire with the county regarding moving petition dollars between roads where there is overage. Town will apply for emergency petitions with the county for heavy rainfall received causing damage on multiple roads. Bennie Road needs a diversion to force water into a field instead of down the road in which it continues to wash out. Kruger will reach out to residents on Bennie Road to review the options. Kruger gave Tollefson the go ahead on creating the diversion on Bennie Road that was recommended by Tollefson for an estimated amount of \$2,075. Knapp Road will need e-matting as the rock is not staying when heavy rains fall.

CHAIR REPORT

Kruger reported that the County will start on Dutter Road this week with chip sealing.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Hansen went over the updated budget and reviewed with the board.

Bills were paid as presented.
